

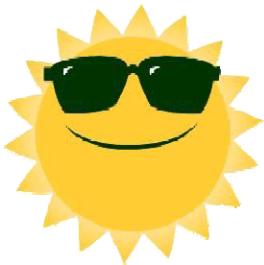

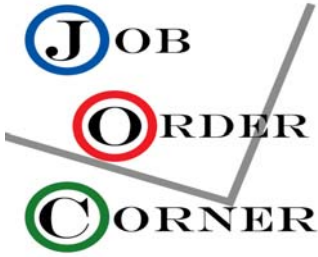

The Alamogordo Public Schools are like other districts across the state at this time of year, they have work that needs to get done while students are enjoying their summer vacations. Unlike other districts, however, they did not have the luxury of time. Thank goodness for CES and their ezIQC® program.

Holloman Elementary School is a school that has issues. These issues are a cause for concern for the both the district and the community with more than forty HVAC units in need of replacement. There are structural issues that need attention as well and they need a contractor that can meet an aggressive schedule, otherwise the school may not open on time.

The district faced the choice of advertising on the street and award to the low bidder, write an RFP and award to the contractor that offers the best value or go directly to a contractor through CES' ezIQC program. The district decided to buy direct.

National Construction Inc., has been in continuous operation in the Alamogordo area since the early 1989. They have successfully completed hundreds of projects within the community and on occasion they will go wherever the work can be found. They have a great reputation for high quality work and their CES contract ensures a competitive price no matter what the economy is doing. National was ready to go when they received a call from the district alerting them to the fact that some summer work was on the horizon. As is their norm, National responded to the challenge and submitted their proposal right on time.

Nothing is ever easy in the construction business and this project will prove to be no exception. Structural failures at the building will require National to hand excavate under the existing grade beams and install flow able concrete to stabilize them. This effort is not without risk and it will also prove to be time consuming. While crews are repairing the footings others will be removing ductwork, HVAC units, and the associated controls so new equipment can be ordered and installed.

The new HVAC units will sit on metal stands that will need to be custom fabricated to fit the field conditions. The new metal stands will span the corridors and the weight of the new units will be transferred to the load bearing walls below. Each new unit will also require ductwork, electrical conduit and wiring and the installation of gas service lines to each unit. After installation of each stand the contractor will have to make each leg of the stand weather tight.

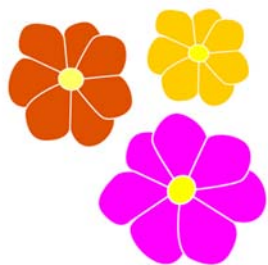

What the students won't realize is all of the effort the contractor went through over the summer to be sure each classroom is cool in the hottest of months and warm in the coldest.
