Students with mental health concerns frequently need support when dealing with a crisis or a traumatic event. Although not therapists, as educators, there are many strategies to employ in assisting these students. Topics include:

- Trauma-informed communication skills necessary to provide needed support
- How to use any behavior as an opportunity to teach prosocial skills
- Resolving staff/student conflict through negotiation
- Developing social skill groups to address behavioral health concerns
