This virtual workshop will cover important concepts in writing effective FBAs and BIPs in all school settings. We will discuss the rationale for using a functional behavior assessment and behavior intervention plan and how and when to determine when one is needed. Topics include:

- Identifying and defining the problem behavior, collecting, and analyzing data, hypothesizing function and differentiating between a skill and performance deficits.
- Strategies to prevent the problem behavior, teaching replacement behaviors, the use of positive reinforcement, designing a response and crisis plan and monitoring success.
