This training is designed for those who want a better understanding of how eligibility for special education is determined with such conditions as ADHD, selective mutism, depression, suicidal ideation, and, especially, emotional disturbance (as opposed to social maladjustment).

Participants will consider when and if it may be helpful to include such eligibilities when a student's primary disability is Autism or Intellectual Disability.

This training will cover what testing should be requested and who needs to do it, what Eligibility Determination Teams need to keep in mind, how to explain the eligibility determination process to parents and staff, and what types of intervention strategies and IEP goals might be helpful for students with neurodiverse or socioemotional or psychosocial challenges.
