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<u>Inclusion</u>, with respect to special education, means creating opportunities for students with special needs to learn and interact with their non-disabled peers in the school setting, primarily in the general education classroom. This training provides information about creating inclusive settings including the following:

- Beliefs about inclusion
- History of inclusion
- Characteristics of inclusive settings / schools
- Models of inclusion
- Educational approaches to instruction
- Resources to support and sustain inclusion

This training is Part 1 of a 4-part series on inclusion and is applicable to <u>all</u> school staff interested and involved in developing inclusive education settings in elementary, middle and high schools.
