Visual scheduling is an evidence-based (and under-utilized) systematic technique that enhances learning and communication for individuals with autism spectrum disorder (ASD) <u>and other needs</u>. Students with ASD often have difficulty attending to and processing lengthy verbal requests. However, research reports that these students attend to visual information more successfully, significantly increasing positive outcomes academically and behaviorally in all settings and levels.

During this workshop, we will demystify the implementation of visual schedules in all settings.
