LEAP: Leading Educators through Alternative Pathways

CES is proud to introduce our new alternative licensure program for teachers, Leading Educators (through) Alternative Pathways (LEAP). LEAP is an innovative, rigorous, fast-track approach in training professionals looking to join the superhero workforce of teaching. Through a grow-your-own model, candidates are chosen by school districts and recommended to apply to the program. Qualified candidates demonstrate a commitment to community, content, and youth while providing examples of the ability to be self-reflective and adjust with feedback.

128 LEAP candidates kicked-off the year with a pre-service institute in preparation to be “day one” ready for New Mexico students. These teachers fill critically needed full-time positions across the state as we face a large teacher shortage.

Teaching is not easy and learning how to teach is incredibly challenging. Their ability to be successful requires support at every level to ensure candidates are effective as they take a leap of faith into classrooms.

LEAP provides in-class modeling and coaching in collaboration with district mentors frequently meeting with candidates to connect LEAP coursework with district experience. Coursework consists of theory, research, and application in the areas of foundational teaching, special education, and reading across the content.

Through monthly regional face-to-face sessions, online modules, and in-class supports, every LEAP teacher who completes the program receives the tools necessary to meet the needs of New Mexico’s diverse student population. LEAP is PED approved for a K-8 Elementary, 7-12 Secondary, and Prek-12 Special Education License. Educational stakeholders across the State have come together to collaborate on the design and implementation of the program ensuring LEAP’s development of teachers in leadership, engagement, achievement, and perseverance.

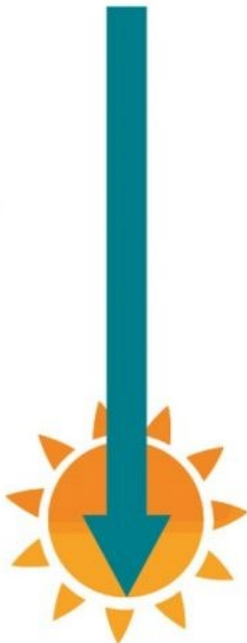

Tip of the Month

You can't be too careful. There seems to be so many cases of check and payment fraud. People are sending emails to change ACH payment information for a vendor or an employee. Do not act on an email. Some of these emails look amazingly valid. Always call the company or employee to see if they are wanting to change their payment information. If they respond that they do, have them complete a payment form. This form should be signed and dated. Check "scrubbing" is another threat. Scrubbing is where the original payee and amount on your check is scrubbed off and another payee and amount is entered and presented for payment at a bank where the thief has a valid account set up. Unfortunately, as soon as the money is illicitly deposited into this account, the money is transferred out. To help prevent this, many banks have a type of "positive pay" service where you upload a check file and any checks presented for payment is checked against the file; checking for payee and amount. Hope you are never hit with one of these fraudulent transactions. Take precautions. You can't be too careful.

Meet Principal Kaye Crecelius: The Principal That Reads Her School to Bed



ALAMOGORDO, NM-- Principal Kaye Crecelius of Desert Star Elementary School in Alamogordo, New Mexico is leading the way in creating a holistic relationship with her students, their parents and the education they receive by the use of social media.

Principal Kaye is known by her students and their families as a familiar face in the hallways, in the community and... on Facebook. Kaye goes live on her “Principal Kaye” Facebook page to read short children’s books just before her kiddos get to bed before another day of learning at Desert Star Elementary.

The idea emerged after Kaye realized that many of her students did not have access to books at home. “I always read my kids books when they were little. I think about how many of my students don't have books at home, so I wanted to do something to remedy that.”

Principal Kaye started her Facebook page as a solution to her students not reading at home, or simply not being able to. Now, her students expect it right as the clock hits 7:30 p.m., they are ready to join (typically with their parents) for a Facebook live reading from Principal Kaye. Kaye asks questions during her readings and encourages her viewers to respond in the comments. She is able to engage in a conversation in real time though this platform.

One night she wasn't able to get on to do a reading and her students made sure to let her know that they were waiting in anticipation. She recalls one of her students saying the next morning: “You didn't read us a story last night Principal Crecelius!” As part of an engagement strategy for literacy, these students are eating it up.

Kaye began her career as an Educational Assistant in Connecticut and felt a calling to the educational setting. She began her studies at Trinity College and studied history, as she was sure at the time that she would become a history professor or instructor in secondary or postsecondary settings. After completing her Bachelor's degree she joined Teach for America and requested placement in a secondary social studies classroom in Louisiana. “I wanted to go to Louisiana, because it was a few years after Katrina.” TFA placed her in an early childhood classroom instead.

At first hesitant, she recollects her falling in love with the early childhood ages. Kaye stayed in the classroom for the first portion of her career and found her way to Alamogordo Public Schools. At APS she was able to be a part of a cohort of aspiring educational leaders in partnership with Grand Canyon University. She earned her Master of Educational Administration and Leadership while enrolled in this program.

Through her journey of becoming an educator and instructional leader, she accounts for one common theme that made it possible for her and other Alternatively-licensed teachers: *mentorship*. *She expressed the importance of experienced educators stepping up to help new ones.*

Desert Star Elementary School is a Title I school with a wide-range of socioeconomic statuses, demographics and backgrounds. For this reason, Principal Crecelius has deemed her school a “magical place.” When speaking to Kaye, the passion for her students’ and faculty’s success becomes quickly evident, “Our teachers and staff absolutely believe that our students are capable of doing anything.”

On any given morning at 8AM you will find Principal Crecelius greeting her students in the lobby by name. She has a relationship with her students and their families that is profound. “Our kids need to believe that we believe in them, it is so important for me to be able to have individual conversations with each of my students.”

She makes a constructive effort to interact with her students' parents as well. "There are so many people who don't know the value of education. It's so crucial to make that connection of the importance. I want our parents to walk into the building seeing me dancing with the students and speaking with them by name to help make that connection. I think it's vital that the environment of Desert Star is always welcoming and warm."

As part of Kaye's live Facebook readings she hopes to bridge her community, students and staff together. She also uses this avenue to model for teachers in literacy instruction. "I can address different common core state standards in these readings."

The infectiously positive school community that is quickly evident at Desert Star Elementary is fueled by what Principal Kaye calls the "constructive culture of relationships."

Through these efforts of engagement and literacy one thing becomes obvious; the power of positivity is infectious in a child's education. Utilizing social media to engage your students is the perfect avenue to offering a "constructive culture of relationship" in your school and community.
