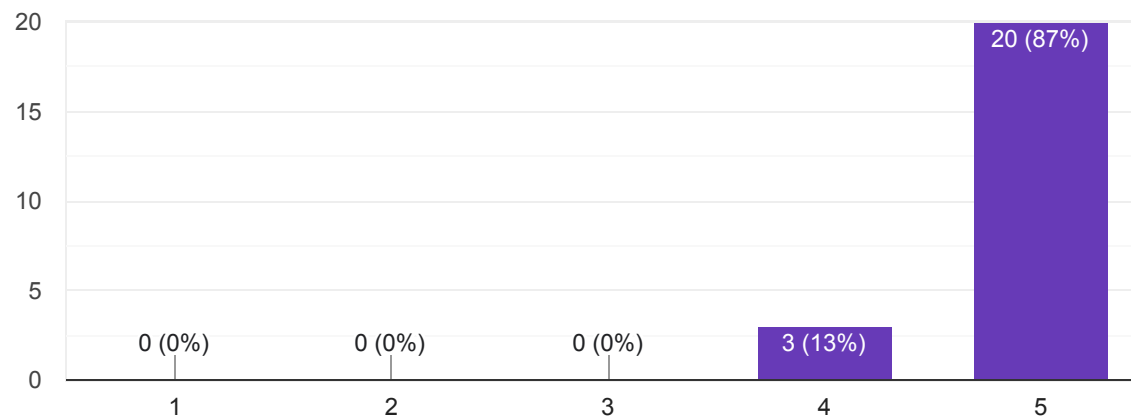

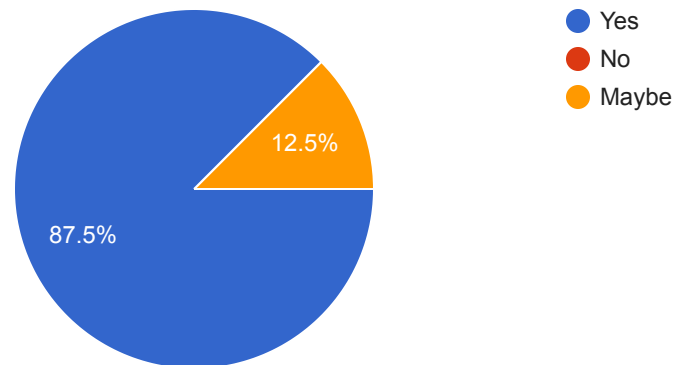
Offer a virtual option

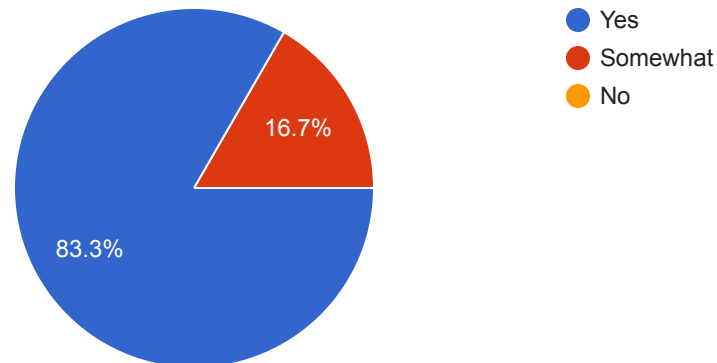
Presentations from bernalillo, Santa Rosa and Coronado!

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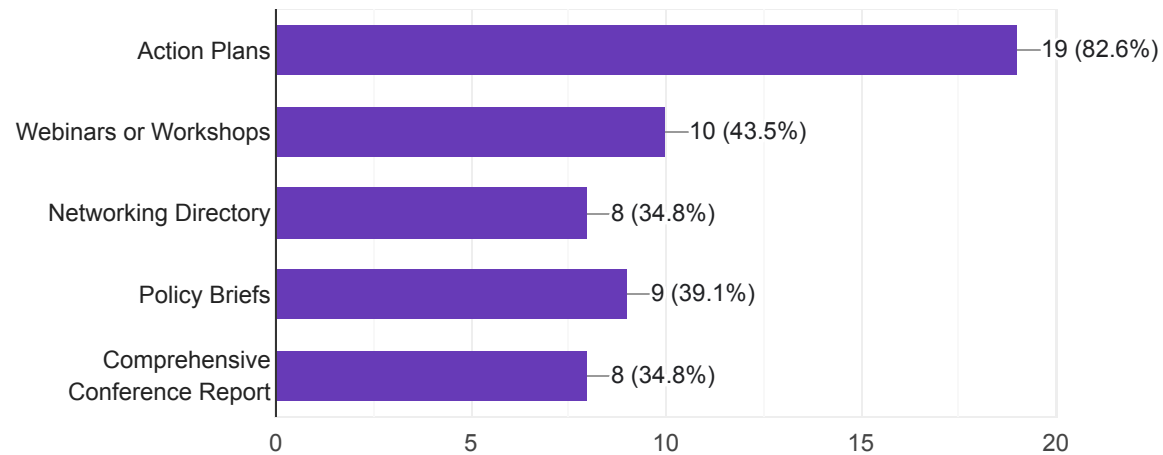
